We desire to partner with Christian families and churches they attend. We understand that some young families have not yet selected a church home. Unlike our kindergarten enrollment, preschool admission does not require a pastor's recommendation. We strongly encourage all families, however, to find a church home, understanding that a child is best served when the home, the school, and the church community are all training them in the ways of the Lord.

When new families apply for K-12 admission, an interview takes place with our admissions director and an administrator. That interview, along with a recommendation from the church pastor, helps us determine if the family will be a good match with Manhattan Christian School. As parents of preschool students, even though you may not regularly attend worship services, we expect that you are promoting a Christian lifestyle in your home. We will do our best to build on that training during those hours your child attends preschool.

We understand that divorce, death, and other circumstances unavoidably result in one-parent households. A single parent has an enormous job of raising children. We would love to come alongside and partner with you in giving you the support you need in teaching your children Biblical principles.

We believe that parents need to consistently teach and model Biblical principles. Unmarried live-in partnerships, whether they are heterosexual or homosexual in nature, are not arrangements we believe to be blessed by God and are, therefore, not aligned with the Biblical missions of our school.
