2023-2024 Theme ABIDE IN CHRIST

Our theme this year is "Abide in Christ". This concept of abiding comes from John 15:4, and while we quote it often, I'm not sure we take into consideration what "abiding" means. Author Brian Hedges puts it this way: When Jesus talks about abiding in Him, three things are implied: connection, dependence, and continuance. These aren't successive steps but interwoven.

Abiding in Jesus means having a life-giving connection to him. A branch is connected to the vine, and a vine to the branch. This is what theologians frequently describe as "union with Christ." Notice that this connection, this union, is mutual. We abide in Him and He abides in us (v. 4). If there is no connection, there is no life, no fruit.

Abiding also implies dependence. This aspect of abiding, unlike connection, is not mutual. The branch is dependent on the vine, but the vine is not dependent on the branch. The branch derives its life and power from the vine. Without the vine, the branch is useless, lifeless, powerless. Sap flows from the vine to the branch, supplying it with water, minerals, and nutrients that make it grow. And believers receive the "sap" of Christ's grace through our life-giving connection to Him. We are completely dependent upon Jesus for everything that counts as spiritual fruit (v. 4). Apart from Him, we can do nothing (v. 5).

Lastly, abiding also involves continuance. This shows us that another aspect of abiding in Jesus is remaining in Jesus. This simply means that we go on trusting, that we keep on depending, that we never stop believing. To abide in Jesus is to persevere in Jesus and His teaching. This is what Jesus is talking about in John 8:31-32, when he says, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

The great reformed theologian, Sinclair Ferguson writes the following: In a nutshell, abiding in Christ means allowing His Word to fill our minds, direct our wills, and transform our affections. In other words, our relationship to Christ is intimately connected to what we do with our Bibles! Then, of course, as Christ's Word dwells in us and the Spirit fills us, we will begin to pray in a way consistent with the will of God and discover the truth of our Lord's often misapplied promise, "You will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you" (John 15:7).

Finally, we are called, as part of the abiding process, to submit to the pruning knife of God in the providences by which He cuts away all disloyalty and sometimes all that is unimportant, in order that we might remain in Christ more wholeheartedly.
